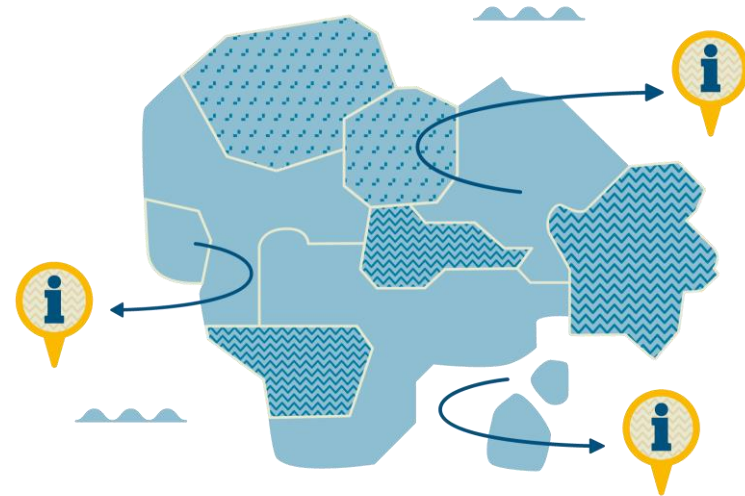

Envisaged outputs. Projects 2014 – 2020

- ❖ **Shared knowledge centres** and **online platforms** to disseminate results and best practice;
- ❖ **Ad hoc studies** and **analysis** on the structures and processes on migration and integration;
- ❖ **Pilot actions** and methods **to increase** handcraft, language and job creation **skills of migrants**;
- ❖ **Transnational tools to enhance** the mutual exchange of information and good practice among public institutions and at various **levels of governance**;
- ❖ Elaboration of **measures** and **instruments** for the **integration** of asylum seekers and refugees **into the labour market**;
- ❖ **Awareness raising**, community and networking activities to **increase** the **involvement** of migrants into the host societies;
- ❖ Demonstration **guides** to the **social** and **economic integration** of refugees with particular focus on the **education system**;
- ❖ **Support** to **migrant's entrepreneurial skills** and assistance to start up business;
- ❖ **Increase** prefabricated **hosting** units.
