Role and Scope of the 2021-2030 National Progress Plan (NPP)


strategic

How SDGs are integrated into NPP?






Correlation between NPP strategic goals and SDGs

Strategic objective of NPP

- 1. Move towards sustainable economic development based on scientific knowledge, advanced technologies, innovations and increase the country's international competitiveness
- 2. Increase the social well-being and inclusion of the population, strengthen health and improve the demographic situation in Lithuania
- 3. Increase the inclusion and effectiveness of education to meet the needs of the individual and society
- 4. Strengthen national and civic identity, increase cultural penetration and creativity
- 5. Improve transport, energy and digital internal and external connectivity
- 6. Ensure good quality of the environment and sustainability of natural resources, protect biodiversity, mitigate Lithuania's impact on climate change and increase resilience to its impact
- 7. Sustainable and balanced development of the territory of Lithuania and reduction of regional exclusion
- 8. Increase the efficiency of the legal system and public administration
- 9. Strengthen Lithuania's influence in the world and relations with the diaspora















Correlation between NPP objectives and SDG targets

Other SDG targets in respect of which major challenges have not been identified

Total – 169 SDG targets

91 (54%)

Addressed directly by the objectives of NPP



Implementing instruments

- NPP horizontal principle Sustainable development
- Indicator rank according to the overall score of SDG achievemen:
 - current situation 36th in 2020
 - target -20^{th} in 2030
- Responsible institutions:
 - Systemic coordinator Ministry on Environment: expertise, consultations on the issue and monitoring the progress of implementation of SDGs
 - Coordinators in all Ministries: ensuring that relevant measures and indicators are included into their national development programs and reviewing that decisions made are consistent with sustainable development principle (as part of RIA)
- Annual reporting on the progress Chapter in Annual Progress Report submitted to the Parliament.

Insights on the TOOL



Useful:

- Provides information about progress on regional level
- Possibility to compare with other similar regions
- Visualization and data sets are available



Could be used:

- As a source of information for monitoring progress of implementation NPP Horizontal Principle
- Planning and monitoring Regional Development Program and 10 Regional Development Plans




Proposals for improving the TOOL
