- It involves all the EU Member States on the Mediterranean from Portugal to Cyprus;
- It involves three IPA Countries (Albania, Bosnia-Herzegovina, Montenegro);
- Due to the territorial cooperation area, the Programme is fully involved in:
 - ✓ development processes such as "Berlin Process" and it can contribute to the most developed area in the EU territory;
 - ✓ EU Macro regional strategies;
 - ✓ EU Sea Basin strategies.
- It complements the cross border Programmes in the Mediterranean.






PANORAMED: main objectives

Migration task in PANORAMED

> Labour market integration

The inclusion of migrants in the labour market is key to ensure their effective integration into the host societies. Through this sub — topic we'll examine if and how projects (will) impact on the employment system and education/training of migrants

Information and Communication

Data source and data exchange are basic in the analysis of migration. Though this sub – topic we'll examine if and how projects (will) develop system of data change, data monitoring, digital platform/channel





> Economic/social inclusion

Though this sub — topic we'll examine if and how projects (will) impact or afford economic and social issues, as education, participation, housing, services for integration in the different levels: country, region and city

> Health

Though this sub – topic we'll examine if and how projects (will) impact or touch the dimension related to basic assistance systems





The added value of AXIS 4 strategic projects

Possibility To go beyond the eligible area, ie towards the **whole Mediterranean** and non EU-neighborhood Countries

Contribution of the strategic projects to the definition of the Mediterranean territorial cooperation and to the support of the territorial policies in the **post 2020** and to the emerging strategies

Contribution of the strategic projects to the **capitalization** of Interreg MED that transforms the results of the ongoing projects into policy and added value for Mediterranean governance.
