Additional information from the Contracting Authority:

1. Yes, the partner of a joint tender can include a subcontractor. The tenderers must describe in their proposal how their cooperation will be organized in order to achieve the expected results. If subcontracting is proposed, the tender must include a document mentioning the reasons why subcontracting is proposed; stating clearly the roles, activities and responsibilities of subcontractor(s).
