Context and objective

Project Description: The ESPON Covid 19 project aims to: 1) analyze the geographical patterns and territorial impacts of the pandemic across the EU; 2) examine the regional and local level policy response to the crisis; 3) investigate whether the crisis presented a window of opportunity for local actors to promote specific regional policy and planning goals/strategies in relation to the just transition, green transition and smart transition.

Workshop Description: This workshop presents the key overall policy findings and recommendations to emerge from the ESPON Covid 19 project. The workshop brings together the Council of European Municipalities and Regions (CEMR), associations of local and regional governments, and other relevant networks together, in an interactive process designed to:
