

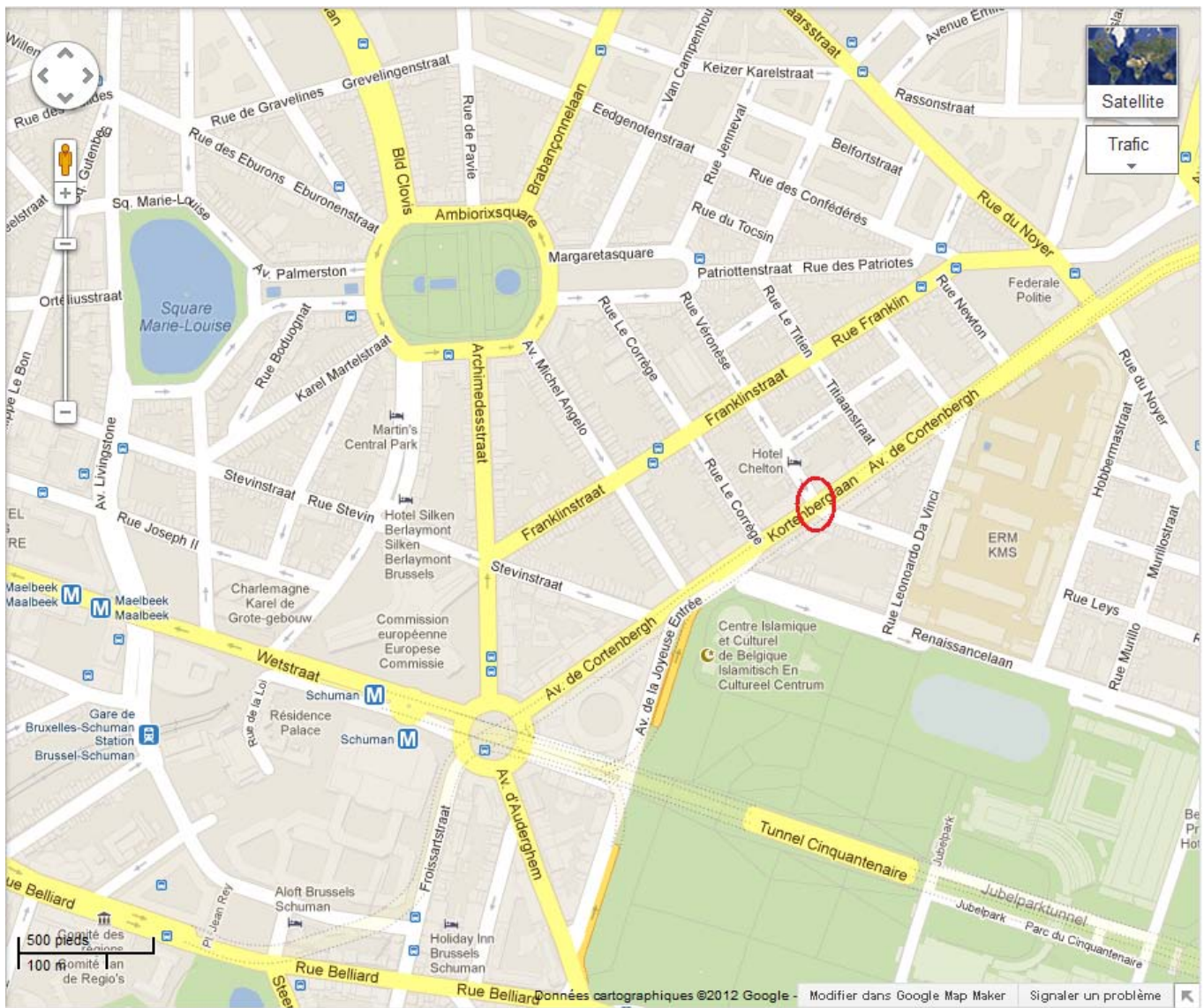

### How to get there:

The closest public transport stop to the venue is Brussels Schuman. This station is serviced by train, by metro and by bus.

#### From Brussels International Airport to Brussels Schuman Station:

- The Airport Express Bus 12 will bring you from the airport directly to the Schuman roundabout. It runs Monday to Friday from 08:00 to 20:00.
- If you prefer to take a train you need to take a train to Brussels North Station. Here you have to transfer to a train to Brussels Schuman Station (direction Louvain-La-Neuve or Liers). The trains run daily from approx. 5:30 to midnight. The travel time is around 30 minutes.

#### From Charleroi Airport to Brussels North Station:

Charleroi Airport is serviced by the so-called low-cost airlines, such as Ryanair. Charleroi Airport offers busses (navettes) to train station *Brussels Midi* (*Brussels South*). There is a navette every 30 minutes, from 04:00 to 20:45 (during weekends until 20:00). From Brussels South you can take a train to Brussels Schuman station (direction Louvain-La-Neuve or Liers).
