#### **Accomodation**

Hotel accommodation in Amsterdam is limited and expensive. Therefore we strongly recommend that you make a hotel reservation as soon as possible.

But there are also rooms pre-booked by the Dutch EU presidency. These rooms, if booked by the booking system detailed below, can be cancelled free of charge till 14 days before check-in.

**IMPORTANT**: At 12 March 2016 half of the pre-booked rooms will be given back to the hotels and from 15 April 2016 the other half. After 15<sup>th</sup> of April you need to book a hotel by your own and good rates cannot be guaranteed at that time.

You will receive an email with login code immediately after you have registered.
