ESPON BT 2050

Aim: Develop territorial scenarios for the BSR in order to increase evidence based on the territorial dimension of the EUSBSR, as well as contribute to EU MS policy-making and cooperation between BSR countries on territorial development. (ESPON EGTC, ToR BT2050, July 2018)

- 1) BSR territorial capital and identification of the main factors shaping the spatial development
- 2) Development of two baseline scenarios 2030 and 2050
- 3) Formulation of territorial development scenarios
- 4) Proposal for political action

Engagement of stakeholders throughout all the phases of the project

Macro-regional approach, visions and scenarios

- Allows dealing with challenges that cannot be addressed or solved neither at the national level nor at the EU level;
- Visions are powerful tools for macro-regions enhancing cooperation where formally regulatory competences to not exist;
- Scenarios are efficient tool to deal with uncertainties and to mediate the dialogue between stakeholders.
- Alternative scenarios facilitates the process of identifying potential benefits and drawbacks of territorial development and situates current decisions in a longer time frame
