## Spatial planning in Provence Alpes Côte d'Azur

## Main features


31 400 km<sup>2</sup> - 5 millions of inhabitants - 159 inhabitants/km<sup>2</sup> - 0,4% population growth (2010-2015)

- Develop a new spatial strategy: SRADDET (co-construction approach)
- Challenges: mobility, affordable housing, climate change, etc...
- Guideline: to reinforce attractiveness of the region, to fight against urban sprawl, to strengthen centralities and organize them in network, to join equality and diversity for solidarity territories.

But...

Still a strong role to the national State (approval of SRADDET, designing fiscal and land use planning systems)

→ More flexible approaches to planning are needed!
