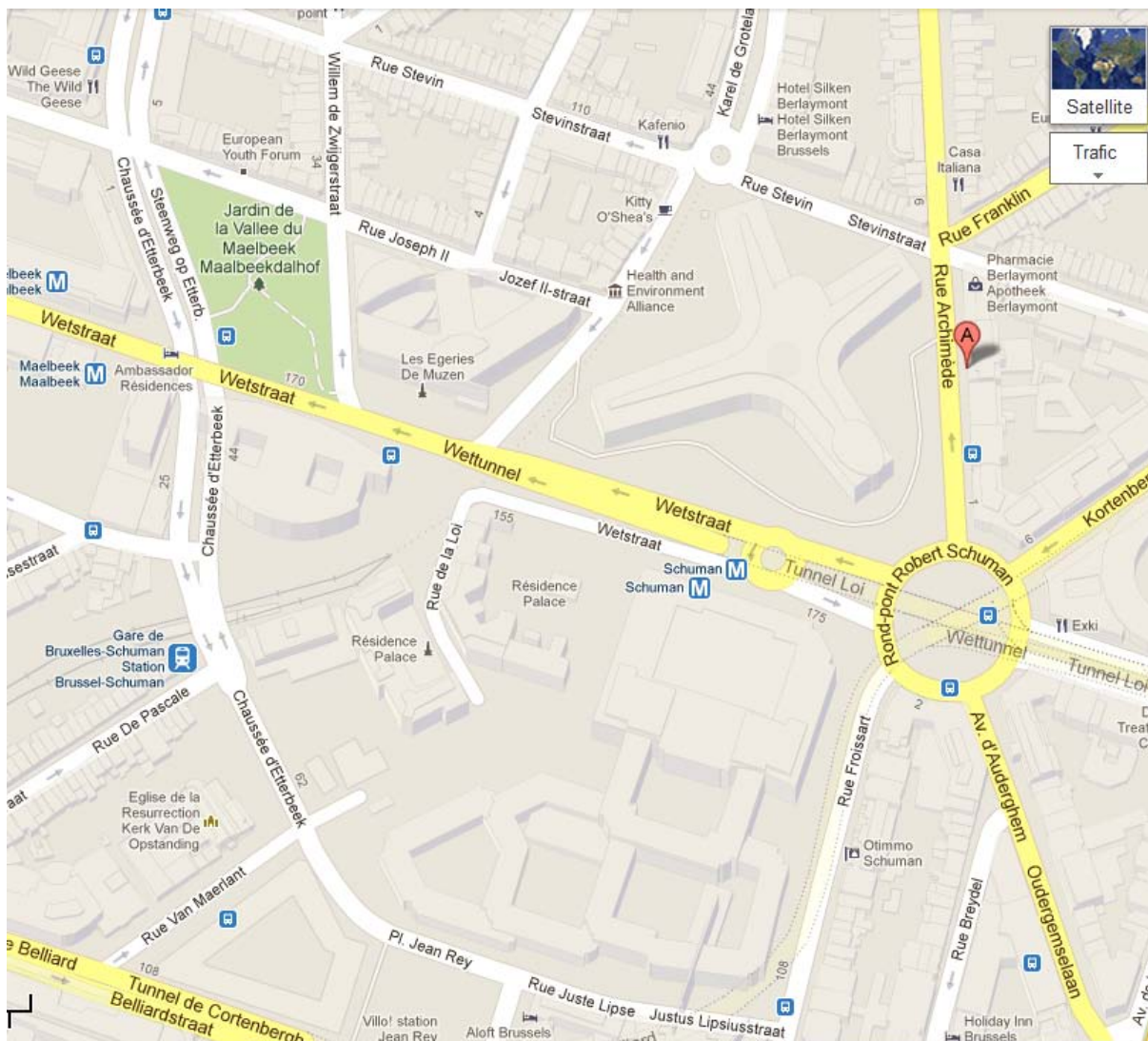


**Stepping into the sea - New evidence on territorial development and the opportunities and risks for European seas and maritime regions**

### **How to get there – by public transport:**

#### From Brussels International Airport to Brussels Schuman Train Station:

From Brussels International Airport you should take the train to Brussels North train station. From Brussels North Train Station you should take a train to Brussels Schuman train station.

Trains from the airport run approx. from 05:30 in the morning until midnight. There are approx. 4 trains per hour. The total travel time from the airport to Brussels Schuman is approx. 30 minutes.

#### From Charleroi Airport to Brussels Schuman Train Station:

Charleroi Airport is serviced by the so-called low-cost airlines, such as Ryanair. Charleroi Airport offers busses (navettes) to train station *Brussels Midi (Brussels South)*. There is a navette every 30 minutes, from 04:00 to 20:45 (during weekends until 20:00). From Brussels South you can take a train or metro to Brussels Schuman train station.

The travel time from Brussels South to Brussels Schuman by train is approx. 15 minutes.

#### From Brussels Schuman Train Station to the venue:

The venue is situated approx. 750 meters from Brussels Schuman Train Station and approx. 250 meters from Brussels Schuman Metro Station.
