At this stage of preparations we plan to concentrate on:

- Advancement of Digital Single Market and digital aspects in all policy areas of the EU
- ✓ Energy Union integrated energy market and security
- EU External relations EU-NATO, EU neighbourhood policy
- In case the Commission will present the proposals for the new MFF 2021+ and the related 7-th Cohesion Report, EE intends to initiate the talks on these files

Urban Development matters

Key themes:

Digital transition - digitalisation of urban governance and services; Implementation of the EU Urban Agenda;
