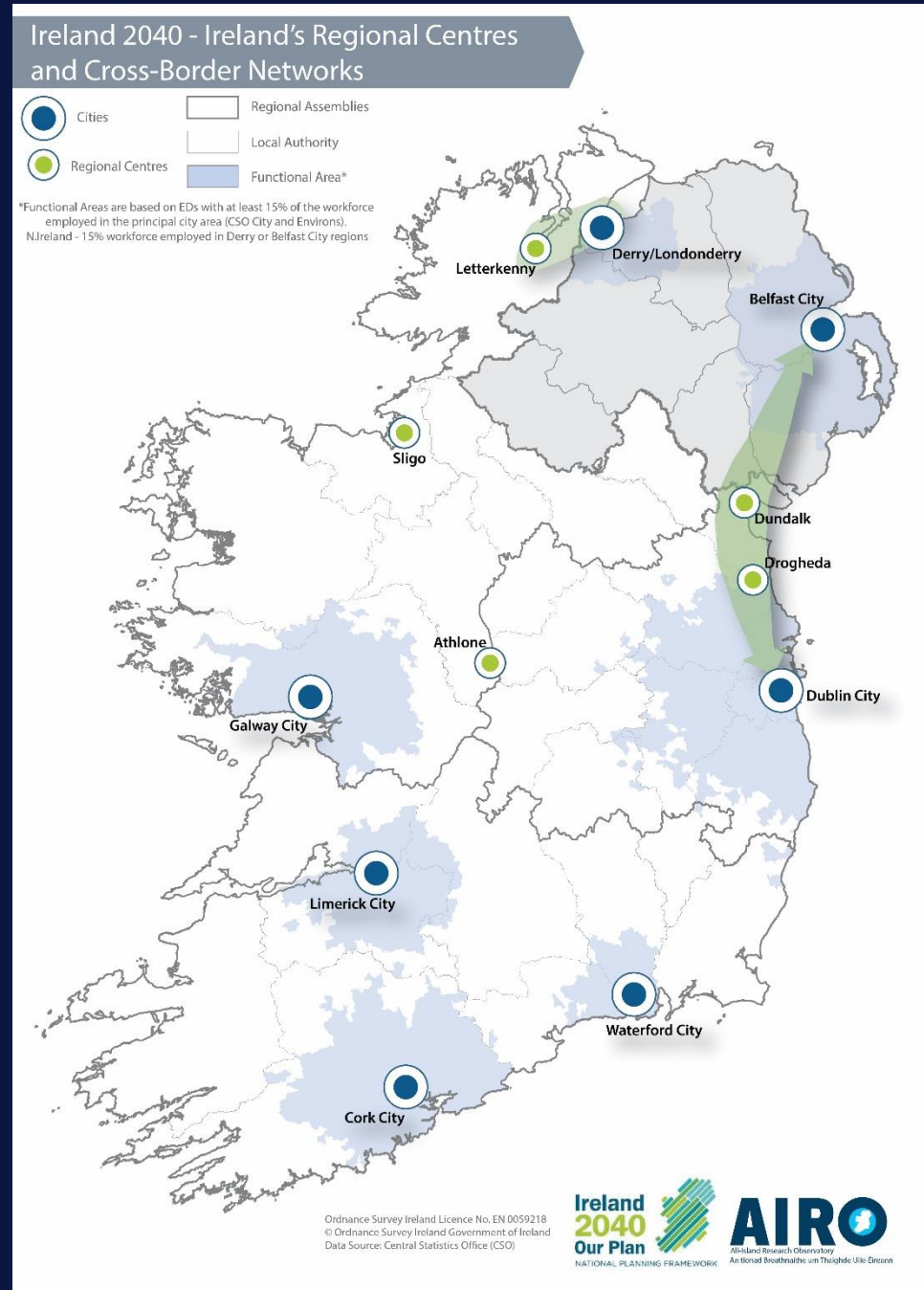

Irish Planning System An Overview



NPF: Issues - Responses

- **Significant growth, primacy of Dublin** – Regional targets, aligned with/backed by national investment plan
- **Relative weakness of Regions/Other Cities** – Focus on limited number of centres of scale
- **Sprawl, rural focus, climate action** – new emphasis on compact growth, urban quality
- **Peripherality, Brexit** – improved connectivity, strengthened networks, alternatives, resilience
- **Implementation** - Regional Strategies, 3 Billion Euro fund to 2027, new Regeneration Agency
