Driving Forces (Source ESPON FOCI Project 2009)

Energy – Driving Forces, e.g.:

Further substitution of gas to oil
Further increase of the share of renewable
energy sources
Stronger external dependence of Europe in
energy supply
Lower increase of energy demand during the crisis

Demographic Change – Driving Forces, e.g.:

Ageing population
Increase of the median age of population
Increase of life expectancy
Returning home of legal migrants
Stronger pressure of illegal migrants
