- Do we need to take a „common view of an area“ and „find common speech“?
- What to pursue, how and what to express ?



Working objectives


- The document deals with:
 - 1) delineation of development areas and development axes of a transnational importance
 - 2) delineation of transport corridors of a transnational importance
 - Aims of the document:

to express in a unified way both thematic spheres (development areas and axes and transport corridors of a transnational importance) within the investigated area, whereas the material will comprise the part describing the state, so the proposed/suggested part

 - May 2008, meeting in Brno




V4+2:

V4+2:


- Working group (compilers)
 - Meetings:
 - October 2008, Budapest
 - June/July 2009 ?, Warsaw
 - Finalization: end of the 2009 or spring 2010 ?



Delineation of development areas and development axes of a t. i.

- Respects the development areas and development axes as they are defined in the national spatial development documents of individual countries
 - Takes selectively over from them all or some parts
 - Interprets them jointly within the whole investigated area
 - Identifies no-continuations
 - Suggests changes and/or supplements of development axes

Development areas and develop. axes of a t. i.




Delineation of transport corridors of a t. i.

- Railways, roads, inland water ways, airports
 - Takes over the corridors from:
 - agreements (paneuropean multimodal transport corridors, TEN-T, EEC OSN – AGC, AGTC, AGR, AGN)
 - other documents (e. g. national high speed lines networks, and others)
 - Identifies no-continuations
 - Suggests changes and/or supplements

Railway corridors of a transnational importance





Road corridors of a transnational importance
